The projects implemented contribute to the modernisation of farms or provide direct assistance for initiating a business venture. The projects to which this publication is dedicated are defined on the basis of the individual regions and also classified in accordance with the differing character of the types of measures being undertaken. They should serve as an inspiring example of how imaginatively, effectively and innovatively it is possible to take advantage of the funds distributed for rural areas.


concerning the Rural Development Programme of the CR 2007-2013

The Rural Development Programme of the Czech Republic (hereinafter referred to as the RDP) is a instrument for obtaining support from the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development that is sponsored by the European Union. The RDP was adopted by the Committee on Rural Development of the European Commission on 23rd May 2007 and, in that same month, the acceptance of applications for grants for a certain group of measures defined in Axis II had already been initiated, followed in July of the same year by the acceptance of applications for selected groups of measures defined in Axes I and III. The total budget for the RDP amounts to EUR 3.6 billion.

The focus of the programme is directed towards the four primary axes that define the main objectives of rural development. The first axis includes measures for the improvement of the competitiveness of the agriculture and forestry industries. The second axis includes measures related to improvement of the environment and of the landscape. The third axis focuses primarily on measures for the improvement of the quality of life in rural areas and for the diversity of the rural economy. Axis IV, using the

the management and administrative capabilities in these areas. At the present time, already in the second half of the programming period, almost all the measures of the RDP are in operation and the high degree of interest in the implementation of these projects can be documented by the fact that, in respect of the individual measures, the budgets for most of these have already been exhausted. In accordance with the Council Regulation (EC) No. 1698/2005, the Ministry of Agriculture has established The National Rural Network (hereinafter referred to as the Network) as a communication platform for the RDP. The Network's activities officially commenced on the 11th November 2008 at a meeting of the Monitoring Committee of the RDP. The Network acts as a "communication bridge" between the European Commission and the Member State(s) in order to channel feedback in regard to the impact of the individual rural development programmes and to their implementation. 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Supporting the competitiveness of agriculture and forestry

The goals of Axis I are to support the competitiveness of agriculture and forestry and to strengthen the dynamics of enterprises involved in agriculture and in the downstream food industry. The budget for Axis I represents 23% of the total budget of the **RDP**.



The priority areas of Axis I are:

- the modernisation of agricultural holdings (support for investments that improve the overall performance of agricultural holdings in order to increase their competitiveness),
- land consolidation (addressing issues concerning the ownership of land, an inadequate agricultural infrastructure or the absence of requisite elements for the ecological stability of the landscape)
- adding value to agricultural and food products (support for the performance of the processing enterprises and for the development of innovation).

Another important aspect is encouraging investment in forestry, by which the dynamic management of forestry, a higher level of performance by forestry enterprises, the restructuring of the forestry sector and the improvement of environmental protection in forestry are supported.

The support of investment activities is complemented by the investment in human resources, especially through counselling, training and information events. Another important feature is the encouragement of the entry of young farmers into the business, supported by payments for early retirement from farming.

Improving the environment and the landscape



The priorities of Axis II include increasing biodiversity, the conservation and development of agricultural and forestry systems with a high added value, the conservation of traditional agricultural landscapes and, additionally, the protection of water and soil. The measures undertaken in Axis II should also contribute to the mitigation of climate change.

The budget for Axis II represents 54% of the total budget for the Rural Development Programme.

The largest proportion of the funding is allocated to **Agrienvironment Measures** (AEM). This broad grouping of measures is targeted towards the promotion of ways of using agricultural land that are consistent with the protection and improvement of the environment, the landscape and their properties (organic agriculture). Also supported are the preservation of managed areas with high nature value (sub-measure landscape management), natural resources, biodiversity and landscape maintenance

(sub-measure management of grassland).

The second largest proportion of the funds allocated is provided in mountain areas and in other less favoured areas (LFA) and is reserved for the **Natural handicap payments** measure. Subsidies are provided for grassland that has a positive environmental impact. This measure also contributes to the stabilisation of the rural population in these areas and provides the farmers with a higher income level.

The utilisation rate of the **Payments within Natura 2000** measure on farmland is influenced by the joint allocation of funds, including for the as-yet unimplemented Water Framework Directive 2000/60/EC sub-measure. Every year, in accordance with this measure grassland is supported in those Natura 2000 areas that are also located in Zone I of the National Parks or in protected landscape areas with an area of 3,700 hectares or more.

From the group of measures targeting the **Sustainable** use of forest land, relatively successfully utilised is the measure Afforestation of agricultural land, which contributes to the increase of biodiversity by the expansion of the forested areas and to the improvement of the ecological balance of the landscape. Also relatively successful have been other measures, such as projects targeted towards the restoration of forestry potential following disasters and those supporting the societal functions of forests.

The quality of life in rural areas and the diversification of the rural economy

The principal priorities of Axis III include job creation, the promotion of renewable energy sources, the improvement of the quality of life in rural areas, including education and information provided to the economic subjects and last but not least also the protection of cultural monuments.

The budget for Axis II represents 54% of the total budget for the Rural Development Programme



The largest proportion of the funding is allocated to the measure promoting the **revitalisation and development of villages**. Based on this measure investment in the basic municipal water infrastructure and projects for the construction and renovation of local roads are implemented and also improvements to the appearance of municipalities and of their public facilities and the obtaining local planning documentation.

Also of equal importance is the measure supporting the diversification of the activities of agricultural entrepreneurs, which is focused on the construction, modernisation and purchase of buildings, machinery, technology and equipment utilised for the diversification of the activities of agricultural entrepreneurs in the direction of non-agricultural activities, including the construction of decentralised facilities based on the use of renewable sources of fuels and energy. The development of small-scale manufacturing and of trades and services is implemented in order to support business creation and development activities. Supporting tourism is intended to encourage the construction of accommodation facilities, including restaurants, and sports facilities with sports equipment rental and additional tourist infrastructure. The final active measure is that of Skills acquisition, animation and implementation which focuses on support for the preparation of an Integrated Territorial Strategy.

Axis IV

LEADER



Axis IV - LEADER represents the methodological axis and it is implemented through the fulfilment of the objectives of the individual measures defined by Axes I - III. The main contribution of Axis IV - LEADER is the means by which the rural development projects are implemented and interconnected.

The purpose of Axis IV - LEADER is to improve the quality of life in rural areas, to support the strengthening of the economic potential and of the appreciation of the natural and cultural heritage of rural areas, while also supporting the management and administrative resources in the rural areas. The principles of LEADER constitute a particularly beneficial method of rural development because they bring about positive effects resulting from the co-operation of different entities that operate in the same rural areas. Local Action Groups (LAG) following the LEADER principle are not acting in opposition to the local government, but more effectively complement the

effort of the revitalisation and development of communities and also contribute to the development of agriculture and the care for nature and the landscape. Currently there are I50 Local Action Groups in the Czech Republic of which I12 were chosen to provide support for the RDP.

In addition to supporting the functioning of the LAGs and the implementation of their Strategic LEADER plans, also supported and integral to the fourth axis is the implementation of cooperative projects at both the national and the international level. The purpose of this measure is to support the use of best practices to strengthen innovative practices and the transfer of knowledge.

The budget for Axis IV represents 5% of the allocation of funds from the RDP.

The South Bohemian Region

South Bohemia is principally an agricultural and tourist area of Bohemia with a rich tradition of fish farming. A part of this fish production is also exported abroad. Cultivated in the fields are undemanding crops such as cereals, oilseeds and, amongst root crops, potatoes. Livestock production is oriented towards beef and dairy cattle. Rural tourism in this region has been developed to a high degree. Projects implemented through the RDP have contributed to the development of the rural areas, to the reduction of any negative impacts of agriculture on the landscape and to improving competitiveness in the production of food commodities. In the rural areas these projects assist business development, create jobs and ultimately strengthen the affiliation of the population.

The characteristics of the project

The project implemented enabled the company to utilise an innovative method for the processing and storage of herbs and plants.

The newly built facility is designed in such a manner that every season the proper and especially a stable temperature and degree of humidity and sufficient air circulation are guaranteed and thereby a significant loss of the healing properties of herbs and plants is avoided.

The project has improved the quality of the stored raw materials and of the finished products, enabling the storage of larger quantities of raw materials and facilitating the widening of the of the product range.

Thanks to the support for the project new jobs were created. The project has also had a positive impact for the buyers and suppliers of the BYLINY Mikeš s.r.o. Company - based on the quality of the products and their wide range it is possible to foresee revenue growth and the implementation of independent investment and development projects.

The characteristics of the project

The purpose of this measure is the support the management of those areas with less favourable conditions in order to protect the countryside, to support environmentally friendly systems and to contribute to the stabilisation of the rural population in these areas. On the farm in Branišov, as part of this measure, maintenance of 25 ha of mountain pastures is provided together with permission for the breeding of 35 head of beef cattle of the Highland breed.

These agri-environmental measures have the purpose of promote ways of using agricultural land that are compatible with the protection and the improvement of the environment and the landscape and of their characteristics. This supports the conservation of managed areas of great nature value, of natural resources and biodiversity and the preservation of the land. The entire Branišov farm is involved in organic farming production with the possibility of marketing the organic beef meat processed in its own slaughterhouse with an organic certificate.

The characteristics of the project

As part of the project a multipurpose premise was created for the social, cultural, educational and sports activities of citizens. Annually it hosts dozens of events with a regional outreach, and the reconstructed premises are used 7 days a week for the requirements of citizens and local associations. Last, but not least, a listed the facade of a Renaissance building was saved and historic spaces in its former cellar were restored. This reconstruction helped to both improve the appearance of the public areas and to improve the quality of life for the inhabitants of the village. The building was granted the prestigious Presta architectural award.

The characteristics of the project

In the centre of both villages street furniture was constructed, which assisted in improving the manner in which the population is kept informed about local upcoming events and activities (sports, cultural, etc.) and those taking place in the surrounding villages. The centre of the village was beautified with ornamental flower-beds and conveniently located benches that conform appropriately with the atmosphere of the village.

From the funds granted a garden tractor was purchased, which enables more regular care of the lawn, thereby helps to maintain the pleasant appearance of the village.

The South Moravian Region

The climate of the South Moravian Region is one of the warmest in the Czech Republic. In the lowlands of southern Moravia the soil is very fertile. This fertility is limited, however, by frequent and significant weather events, i.e. either extreme drought or flooding. The southern part of the agricultural region, in particular, is frequently affected by drought, while in the same area the largest overflow and flood areas in the Czech Republic are located. These two extremes fundamentally influence both the care of the land and the agriculture. Cereals, canola and corn are grown there, together with fruits and vegetables on a much smaller scale. The region also includes the largest area of vineyards in the Czech Republic. In recent years there has been a significant decline in the quantity of livestock, cattle and pigs. Since 2010 a thematic working group focussing on the effects of extreme drought in arid areas has been active in the South Moravia Region. One of its additional outputs is an analysis with the goal of suggesting possible measures for maintaining soil quality and for improving the water regime, the environment and the quality of life in rural areas.

The characteristics of the project

The construction consists primarily of a water reservoir with an area of 1,200 m2 including a drain facility and a piped gully, DN 800, 240 m in length.

A sedimentation reservoir, recreating the form of wetland, with an overflow was constructed on the feeder together with the necessary reinforcement to the right bank of the ravine that consists of three log dams and with accompanying greenery.

The implementation of this project has provided for a reduction of flood flows and for the retention of water in the land-area during torrential rains. It creates an element in the landscape that fulfils both environmental and aesthetic requirements and also the function of creating a habitat for plants and animals and providing possibilities for recreation and for sport fishing.

Lastly, the modified area serves as a resting place for cyclists.

The characteristics of the project

As part of the Integrated Production sub-measure Wineries Kosík has received a subsidy for blocks of land containing vineyards. The subsidy itself assists in reducing the cost of treating the individual vineyards and the funds saved are invested in better protection of the vineyards and in modern technology. A major benefit is the reduction of the environmental burden in the manner of controlling the quantity of chemicals that are utilised for the protection of the vines. Since this is a long process, only in the next generation will it be possible to assess the improvement to the quality of the environment - this seems in any case like a step in the right direction.

The characteristics of the project

The Company Management decided to construct a biogas plant (hereinafter referred to as "BGP") as a replacement for the terminated production of pork. A fully functioning BGP should restore the missing revenue and reduce dependence on commercial companies since, due to the cancellation of the pork production the consumption of feed grains decreased.

The implementation of the project has contributed not only to the stabilisation of revenues, but also to maintaining employment in the region, to improvements in the handling, storage and use of the liquid manure (slurry, dung water) produced by cattle breeding and to the reduction of the odour of this operation. Putting the BGP into operation generated the need for undertaking an additional project; now it will be necessary to construct facilities for utilising waste heat. In the first stage a heat pipeline should be constructed that would provide heating to the existing buildings (the hygiene facilities, workshops, offices, etc.). However, this will only ensure the use of a part of the waste heat generated. For the remaining waste heat another suitable method of application is being sought.

Currently a study is being prepared, based on which it is planned to select the optimal manner of utilising this energy source. Under consideration, for example, is the drying of digestate, lumber, etc.

The characteristics of the project

Historically, the land of Bohemia and Moravia has for centuries been cultivated farmland with orchards and gardens, the acreage of which, however, has been decreasing as people's interest in the landscape has changed. The project for cooperation between the three local action groups (LAG) "Rural landscape traditions in Bohemia and Moravia" in a wide range of activities has revived the interest of locals and tourists alike in fruit growing, viticulture, apiculture and other such crafts in relation with local consumption, gastronomy, the activities of associations and in agritourism.

Identified and planted in the region as part of the project (in collaboration with the local people) were forgotten traditional fruit trees, such as Rowanberry, for example. All of the species and varieties planted have been documented and a poster - "Rare fruits of Bohemia and Moravia" - was printed. One overall result of the project is the publication of the "Cookbook from the Countryside of Bohemia and Moravia" containing recipes for preparing traditional dishes from both the fruits and the other gifts of nature to our regions. Other activities carried out as part of the project include the planting of gene-pool orchards, in which educational panels are displayed. Also made accessible were various other locations that are thematically linked to the project, thematic exhibitions were prepared and various events were supported, at which visitors could become acquainted with the traditional products and crafts of this specific region. From amongst the wide-ranging menu of events and activities it is possible to specifically mention, for example, a distillery and cider house in Strážnice, that carries out the production of cider and spirits, and where there is an exhibition of fruit and grape processing together with a demonstration of the traditional technological procedures utilised.





The Karlovy Vary Region

The character of the climate and the quality of the agricultural soils of the Karlovy Vary Region do not create conditions that are favourable for intensive agriculture. In the foothills and the mountainous areas where there is a predominance of grassland and pasture primarily cattle and sheep are bred. Cereals are successfully grown on the land that is of higher agricultural quality and also rape which has a long historical tradition. An important feature of this area is the ecological manner of farming utilised. The Rural Development Programme is an important source of funding for projects focused, for example, on the reconstruction of stables, shelters, refuse-depositories, haylofts, grain silos, biogas plants, enclosed arenas for training horses, etc. Additionally supported from these funds are activities directed towards the construction of small-scale processing establishments, such as dairies, slaughterhouses, fruitdrying plants, cheese manufactures, etc. The funds are also used to support projects focused on interesting activities organised by municipalities or non-profit organisations.



The characteristics of the project

During the period of reconstruction the remaining building of the destroyed former stables was utilised. After the completion of all the work the building had been completely renovated, with a new system for housing and feeding that corresponds to the requirements for organic sheep farming. The capacity of the sheepfold is for 616 sheep in free-standing pens. This reconstruction enabled the farm to develop additional business activities - milking sheep and making cheese and other dairy products based on organic farming.

The implementation of this project has contributed to the preservation of jobs in this area with a high unemployment rate, while at the same time increasing the competitiveness of the company that also operates in harsh mountain conditions.

The characteristics of the project

The implementation of the RDP measures has contributed to the adequate maintenance of the land around the farm and to the improvement of the overall environment in this region. Great losses had been experienced on the arable land, due to consistent damage by forest animals to the cereals grown. Grassing, however, eliminated this problem and the company has also achieved an improvement in the financial balance of its business. The permanent grassland is now treated during its vegetation so that there has not been so much damage to the arable land. In the areas of permanent grassland a herd of suckler cows is pastured. Based on this scheme the costs for animal feed, energy and fuel consumption are saved. Also significantly decreased is the amount of manual labour by employees required. High school students and other interested persons from the agricultural world and the professional public have also been familiarised with the positive benefits of these farming methods. The implementation of these measures has contributed to a significant improvement in the farm environment and to the living standards both of its employees and of residents around the farm. Our goal is to persevere with these efforts and to not only contribute to the creation of better working conditions in agriculture but also to preserve the environment of this region.

The characteristics of the project

The Church of St. Catherine dates back to the 12th Century and it was declared a cultural monument by the Ministry of Culture, listed under number 11508/4-5087. The church was destroyed and rebuilt several times in the past. Since the year 2009 the building has been under the ownership of the municipality of Křižovatka, which initiated the construction and restoration work that is led to the rescuing of the single object in the village possessing a cultural heritage. The rescue work on the church was divided into three phases - currently ongoing is the second phase, which should be completed during the year 2013. After the reconstruction and restoration work has been completed a permanent exhibition about the Křižovatka municipality and its surroundings will be installed in the church. At the same time the monument will also be used for a variety of social and cultural events, such as concerts, exhibitions, ceremonies, funereal farewells and others.

The characteristics of the project

Through the establishment of the Art Workshop in the attic of the Nursery School, premises were also created suitable for gatherings of the people of the village, for mothers with children and, at the same time, opportunities for artistic enjoyment by the kindergarten pupils were expanded.

The workshop can be utilised not only for artistic activities, but also for gatherings of children who play musical instruments.

The establishment of the workshop has made for the effective utilisation of the attic-space of this municipal building. Interesting opportunities have been created for its active leisure time usage by the children and the young people of the village.

The characteristics of the project

This project was implemented on a family farm in Rokytnice v Orlických Horách, where cows have already been bred since 1991. In recent years, the purchase price for milk by dairies had dropped to such exploitative levels that the farmers decided to process and sell a part of their production independently. The purchase of a small container dairy proved a huge benefit, especially for enhancing the quality of the dairy products. Another positive aspect of this project has been the rapid growth in the production of products and the increase of their independent sales. People from the surrounding area and visitors to the Orlické Mountains find their way to the farm and often go shopping for their favourite milk, kefir, cottage cheese, yoghurt, butter and various types of cheeses. Additional development of the farm could support the purchase of a cooled vehicle that could deliver products to more distant supply points or sell them directly at the increasingly popular farmers' markets.

This ecological orchard was already established here in 1999. Covering an area of 5.22 ha, 8,000 trees of resistant cultivars were planted here. The motivation for this activity was to demonstrate in practice that the ecological production of fruit without the use of synthetic pesticides and fertilisers is sustainable, that it contributes to the protection of nature and provides people with healthy fruit. The orchard is currently visited by excursion groups, both from within the Czech Republic and from abroad, including high-school and university students. The farmer published his experience of this work in a methodological publication and has also been involved in the creation of schoolbooks. These activities have contributed to the popularisation of organic farming and they have also inspired many followers. The orchard on the hill above Hořice constitutes a significant element of the landscape while offering a very rich biodiversity including many species of fauna and flora. The number of people who are interested in buying directly from "the farmyard" continues to increase. In 2008 the farmer was awarded the annual "Barták's pot" prize as the best organic farmer in the CR. The RDP subsidies support the farmer's ability to conduct his business in accordance with a strictly organic regime and are essential for helping to bridge the difficult times (e.g. seasonal and climatic fluctuations).

Prior to the construction of separated sanitary sewers, waste water was either discharged through septic tanks into settling tank, from which the water then flowed into the Bystřice River or it was retained in the septic tanks of individual households. Now this polluted water is let out to a wastewater treatment plant. This has reduced the quantity of pollutants flowing in the Bystřice River, the final effect of which is that this contributes to the improvement of the environment of this region. After connecting to the new sewerage system, citizens no longer need to worry about emptying their septic tanks and cesspools and there is also a considerable financial saving in the family budgets of the individual households.

The characteristics of the project

The Committee for the Maintenance of Monuments from the War of 1866 is a civic association that is dedicated to the tradition of protection of the heritage of the War of 1866. In respect of the care of war graves and memorials of 1866 the Committee 1866, together with other participating institutions, has succeeded during the last 20 years in saving, reconstructing and repairing almost 700 war graves and memorials out of the total number of the more than 1300 war graves from 1866 that are located within the territory of the Czech Republic. The sites that have been reconstructed as part of this project are visited by members of the general public of all ages and social groups. The reconstruction of the monuments and making them accessible has led to a significant recovery of certain individual communities and to the improvement of the environment of the battlefield complex situated close to Hradec Králové. The monuments are also located on the routes of nature trails and are frequently visited by both domestic and foreign visitors. Thanks to this project the memorials from the war of 1866 were rescued and these war graves were returned to a decent condition. All the monuments on the individual battlefields create a unique series of monuments of military funeral architecture of the 19th and 20th centuries that has existed there for more than 140 years and that is unique in Europe.





The Vysočina Region

The Vysočina Region is one of the colder regions of the Czech Republic, with less fertile soil. Potatoes are a typical crop from the stony fields. Also widespread is the cultivation of cereals and forage crops; at higher elevations the soil is particularly well suited for growing rye and oats. The region is also characterised by cattle breeding and milk production. Funded from the RDP resources are a variety of projects and activities - such as the repair and construction of stables, dung holes, reservoirs, warehouses; supported is the processing of regional products through the promotion of small plants and the acquisition of new technologies. It is also possible to obtain funding for the afforestation of agricultural land. Also supported are activities targeted towards the development of tourism, the diversification of nonagricultural activities and other interesting activities intended to assist in the development of this region.

The characteristics of the project

Since 1999 the farm has been recognised as an eco-friendly enterprise. One of its main business activities is the breeding of pigs. Pigs are raised on the farm in a unique manner in groups that are defined as "families". This method, together with the animals staying in the fresh air in enclosures, defines the breeding and rearing of pigs with a maximum emphasis on their welfare and this is viewed as a prerequisite for the subsequent achievement of products of organic quality. With an increasing demand for its products the applicant realised the necessity to solve the production processing by being independent of the contractual processors. A noneconomic effect of the project is the elimination of the stress experienced by animals during their transport to the slaughterhouse.

As part of the project, adjustments to the former farm dairy were made in order to construct an on-site slaughterhouse. The appropriate technology for the slaughter of animals and for chilled meat packaging was installed. By putting the slaughterhouse into service a closed production cycle was introduced on the farm, from the input material to the end-product without any significant movement of materials, raw materials or animals. Another important benefit of the project was ensuring the greater financial stability of the applicant.

The outdoor cinema in Moravské Budějovice was already established in 1973. It consists of an auditorium area, a stage with a proscenium, operational equipment, a projection booth block, stairways for the arrival and departure of visitors and a lighting system. Until 2007 these premises were used only occasionally, for cultural events such as concerts and musical shows. The projectors located in the projection booth remained unused for about 15 years. The project implemented is intended for the benefit of the general public and has positive aspects both for the citizens of Moravské Budějovice and for all those in the wider area of Moravské Budějovice who are interested in it. The refurbishing of the projection equipment and the purchase of new audio speakers have enabled film screenings throughout the entire summer season. Thereby the options for cultural experiences in the town have been augmented.

This year the reconstruction of the cinema continues with another improvement which is the construction of new toilets. During the following year the modernisation of the premises will continue with the reconstruction of the lighting for the public area, while in subsequent years the restoration of the stairway is planned. The gradual implementation of these individual activities contributes to the value of the premises and the upgrading of the facilities, which can also be used by the Municipal Cultural Centre, as well as by other organisations and associations, supports the organising of a variety of cultural events.



The characteristics of the project

The reconstruction of the milking parlour has greatly increased the labour productivity (by cca. 50%) and thanks to the automatic sanitation equipment the milk quality indicators have also improved. Currently 300 goats and 400 sheep are milked daily — the milking parlour is adapted to deal with both species. The improvement in the milk quality is reflected in the delicious taste of our products. All the milk drawn is processed in our own facility into cheese, yoghurt, cottage cheese, kefir, etc. Interest in these products exceeds our production capacity. Sheep and goat breeders are able to participate in a tour of this parlour, the technology of which is very interesting.

Subsidies granted for farming in less favoured areas help to compensate for the natural handicaps of these areas. In the pastures that are located in LFAs, the yield of the grassland is lower and the gain in weight of the cattle is not comparable to the national average. The LFA payments minimise the losses resulting from this lower income and contribute to the continued presence of meat breeds in pastures. Thanks to the subsidy, the applicant is able to continue to work with suckler cows and to invest not only in their welfare (drinking facilities in pastures, feeding from the feeding vehicle in winter, the mowing of the ungrazed areas and mineral supplements in the form of licks, etc.), but also to increase their genetic potential through selected top breeding bulls in an attempt to minimise the differences between the weight gains of bulls reared in LFAs and of bulls reared under normal conditions. With support from the Rural Development Programme it is possible to care for the countryside and to preserve the landscape for future generations. Regular mowing of meadows and pastures contributes to maintaining the grassland speciesrich and not overgrown with teasel and the result of other seedage; a feature that is certainly appreciated both by the local residents and the general public, those who use this area for recreation.

The subject of this project was reconstruction work on the Church of the Holy Trinity. The Church of the Holy Trinity is a cultural monument registered in the Central Register of the Cultural Heritage under registration number 16876/5 - 3217. The work consisted of the reconstruction of the drainage throughout the premises - the repair of the existing drainage and the restoration of the gutters and the downspouts. Additionally carried out was the replacement of the damaged roofing, the restoration of the façade including its stone elements, the repair of the doors and the windows fittings, the renovation and replacement of the door and window infill. The project also included securing work, which consisted of the installation of reinforcing rods in the tower, the bracing of the saddle roof and of masonry faults and restoration of the area of a faulty header.

The repairs included new wiring, new interior plaster and floors, including waterproofing the warehouse, workshop and garage, the replacement of windows and entrance doors to the outbuilding area of the premises and the replacement of the garage doors.

The minor repairs included attaching flashing to the barn and fixing the chimney head.





The Pardubice Region

The greater part of the area of the Pardubice Region is occupied by fertile agricultural land and the most important agricultural area of the region lies along the Elbe River. Mostly grown there are cereals, beets, corn, potatoes and oilseed rape. In the foothill areas the farmers grow oats, potatoes and flax. Also utilised in the region is Axis II of the RDP, whereby support for less favoured areas contributes to the conservation of the landscape, the maintenance of cattle rearing and the preservation of jobs. The financial resources of the RDP have contributed to the modernisation of cattle stables and poultry-houses and, to a lesser extent, they have also focused on pig farming. The completed projects have led to better animal welfare and a growth in labour productivity. The stability of the farms has been significantly facilitated by the upgrading of the post-harvest grain lines and the construction of biogas plants. The application of the LEADER method has facilitated the restoration of a dialogue between the local authorities, the associations, the businesses and farmers in the rural areas.

Another equally important process is the actual breaking down of the raw materials into a very fine fraction, which is achieved by grinding in suspension while following strict temperature requirements.

The implementation of the project initiated the implementation of a range of possible procedures for the processing of the mushrooms grown that are of organic quality. Thereby the company clearly distinguished itself from similar manufacturers and suppliers who operate throughout the territory of Czech Republic in the production of items of unidentifiable quality. The company was also included in a programme for the testing of grown and processed mushrooms and of their effects on the human organism. The implementation of this project enabled the company to continue its further development, which includes the growing and processing of medicinal mushrooms, in such a manner as to preserve all the active substances that they contain.

Through the purchase of the P32.6Lplus telescopic manipulator the treatment of forest land following its clearing was significantly accelerated and improved; the brushwood is immediately removed from the newly cleared areas and made ready for fresh planting. Thereby there is no necessity to use such large quantities of chemicals to support the new growth and thereby the costs of the silviculture operations are correspondingly lower.

The manipulator is also utilised for the revitalisation of the forest roads and this thereby the ease of access to the forests is improved both for the felling equipment and also for the general public (much utilised are the cycling paths). Each spring the roads are cleared, any sections that are impassable are sprinkled with crushed materials and also amelioration of the drainage is implemented. Unfortunately it also has to be used for the disposal of illegal landfills that still appear around the forest land.

Also under consideration in regard to the modifications already carried out is the restoration of the currently defunct water reservoir inside the park. The restoration of both the terraces evokes the atmosphere of the historic Baroque period, i.e. the period during which the château complex was constructed, while the design respects both the surviving historical documentation and at the same its current status with the quality of the trees and shrubs. The implementation of the project has restored the former beauty of this area. In 2008 the Municipal Council decided to undertake a comprehensive revitalisation of the small-scale buildings within its area that represent the historic rural architecture in order to restore these buildings to their original purpose as places for meetings, meditation or relaxation.

The primary objective of the project was the physical preservation of this unique rural heritage. Without rapid intervention and the professional restoration of the buildings their destruction would have been irreversible. An equally important goal, that it was also possible to achieve through this project, was through these fixed sites and their landscaped surroundings to enhance the atmosphere and beauty of the municipalities of the Dolní Lukavice district. Nine individual sites underwent reconstruction; some of these are now also floodlit. The implementation of this project, by its scope, evoked a strong response in the region and inspired a desire to continue with similar activities. In 2011 the municipality therefore followed up on this with another project supported by the RDP entitled "Resting corners for all generations".







Prague and the Central Bohemian Region

The Central Bohemian Region is characterised by its considerable diversity. Most of the agricultural land is arable; in the southern part of the region there are meadows and pastures. Vineyards and hop garden also enjoy a significant status and there are also large protected areas. The warm climate and fertile soil of the Elbe lowlands enable the cultivation of cereals, sugar beet, corn and a variety of vegetables. These agricultural products constitute the raw materials for many of the local factories that process food. Of great importance for the development of rural areas have been the subsidies provided for the renovation and development of villages, for public facilities and services, for tourism and for the development of handicrafts. For increasing the competitiveness of farms, significant projects have been implemented targeted at adding value to agricultural and food products and supporting the modernisation of businesses and projects. The project focuses on the utilisation of acacia wood, which is notable for its hardness and durability. In accordance with the requirements of customers from all over the Czech Republic, studs for livestock fencing, various profiles for the construction of outdoor terraces, garden furniture and small structures for playgrounds are produced.

The waste from the acacia is utilised as firewood. Such debris as sawdust and wood chips are utilised as material for the production of wood fuel-pellets. Also processed is the waste from two nearby joineries and a sawmill. Chips from other trees that have been disposed of in association with the management of the landscape around municipalities are also utilised. For making agri-pellets hay from low quality grasslands is used that is not suitable for feeding to livestock, together with straw purchased from small-scale farmers. The production of pellets helps to meet the needs of users of ecological boilers and contributes to the environmental improvement of this primarily industrial area of Mělník in Central Bohemia.

The entire building (the former farmhouse), including the granary (now a workshop) is a cultural monument (part of the Merboltice Village Conservation Area). In the course of cultural and social events the Calvary on Ostrá Hill became a meeting place for the general public of all age groups. This project contributed to the development of tourism in the Úštěk district and to the preservation of this important landmark for future generations.





The Zlin Region

Mainly grown in the foothills are potatoes, oats, flax and rape. The mountain meadows are utilised for grazing.

In the lowlands in Hanna, along the Olšava and Morava Rivers, there exist very good conditions for growing fruits, vegetables, cereals and sugar beet. Grapevines thrive in Slovácko and are grown there in large vineyards. The impact of the RDP in the Zlín Region can be evaluated prior to the end of the current programming period as being highly significant and positive. Through investments subsidised by this programme a number of successful projects have been implemented - such as a post-harvest processing line, a biogas plant, various multi-purpose facilities in villages, business premises have been modernised, machinery has been acquired, etc. A number of the events that have contributed to improving the quality of life for the citizens of the region were implemented through Local Action Groups.

The characteristics of the project

The implementation of this project enabled the development of new products, with an assortment of lactic-acid fermented and pickled vegetables in flexible packaging, completely free of chemical preservatives. These products therefore have a high added value and a high quality standard, enabling the expansion of the portfolio of these products for the Czech market and the possibility of their export to foreign markets.

The raw material base of these products comes from primary agricultural producers, primarily from within the Czech Republic. The commencement of their serial production is contributing to the recovery in vegetable production in the Czech Republic. This project therefore has a positive impact, not only on employment in the district of Uherské Hradiště, but also on jobs in other regions focusing on agricultural production.

The project enables actively responding to the ever increasing demands of end customers to whom high-quality Czech products can be offered. Also playing an important role is the greater competitiveness of these products in comparison with those manufactured in other European countries in which the level of support for agriculture and the food industry is higher.

The characteristics of the project

The project for the reconstruction of an abandoned former café and a butcher's shop has brought new job opportunities for local citizens. The bakery building has become the new centre of the community, the place where locals and visitors to the village can buy fresh bread daily. In the morning customers who are passing by stop in at the bakery, especially for a snack when they are on a business trip; school trips plan to stop there for their refreshments.

The demand for local pastry inspired a related investment – the expansion of the capacity of the bakery with a new bread production line in Holešov. Also notable is the interest of people from the surrounding areas of the Moravian-Silesian and Olomouc Regions. After its first year of operation the company has received the "HANNA - REGIONAL PRODUCT" Certificate for the quality and originality of its recipes. This certificate guarantees the product quality, environmental friendliness and uniqueness, which is assessed as the combination of the tradition of production, the utilisation of local raw materials, craftsmanship and its specific regional origin.

The characteristics of the project

The implementation of this project has succeeded in breathing new life into a dilapidated complex of historically valuable parish buildings. In the renovated premises modern facilities for the Christian youth community have been created, in association with various other parish activities (the church choir, the schola, a missionary club, a community of acolytes, a community of families). There is also a newly established museum dedicated to local native Arnošt Hrabal, a famous graphic artist and priest who served in the parish from 1937 to 1969. The parish complex is located at the very centre of the village, close to the baroque Church of St Martin and the Buchlovice Chateau, a national monument.
